Each Spring, students across the nation take The CollegeBoard's Advanced Placement (AP) exams. The courses leading up to these exams help demonstrate that students are ready for the rigors of college and beyond. Additionally, strong performance on these AP exams may lead to students' earning college credit and/or advancement in their courses. You can find more information at https://apstudent.collegeboard.org/takingtheexam regarding the specifics of dates, times and details of each exam.

For the 2022 AP exams, students at Watchung Hills Regional HS will be registering online. In order to register, students should click on the link provided on the school website or visit www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/311231 to register. To complete registration, students must answer all of the required questions. Registration is not complete until students have navigated to the confirmation page.

Watchung Hills Regional HS is excited to offer families the convenience of paying exam fees online at the time of registration. Please be sure to have a **credit card or debit card available before beginning registration**. Paying online is a great way to make sure that payment has been made while avoiding mailing payment. This year each AP exam costs \$101.00.

We know that parents may desire to register their students for exams. We strongly recommend that parents and students are both present while registering to ensure that the correct exams are ordered. Students who have previously registered with Total Registration must use the same email and password as in past years.

Please complete the Total Registration process by **Monday, November 8th at 3pm.** After this date, there will be additional late fees (\$20 fee from November 8 to November 15th; \$40 after November 15th).
