Mc Garry Scholarship, the Prichard-Murphy Memorial Scholarship, and the Kenneth G. Herrmann Scholarship.

The Green Brook Lions Club Scholarship applicant must be a Green Brook resident who demonstrates a reasonably high level of academic achievement and be of good character. The student must continue their formal education in a two- or four- year college or a vocational program. The main consideration will be the applicant's involvement in working with the handicapped, the infirm or the less fortunate, and show their involvement in community service. A minimum of \$1,500 will be awarded for this scholarship.

The David T. McGarry Scholarship applicant must be a Green Brook resident who will continue their formal education in a two- or four- year college and be pursuing a degree in business, and must show good math skills, exemplified by good grades and advanced classes. A minimum of \$1,000 will be awarded for this scholarship.

The Prichard-Murphy Memorial Scholarship applicant must be a Green Brook resident who demonstrates a reasonably high level of academic achievement and be of good character. The student must continue their formal education in a two- or four- year college or a vocational program. The main requirement is that the candidate will be continuing their education in the field of education or fine arts. A minimum of \$500 will be awarded for this scholarship.

The Kenneth G. Herrmann Scholarship applicant must be a Green Brook resident who will continue their formal education in a two- or four- year college and be pursuing a degree in engineering, and must show good math skills, exemplified by good grades and advanced classes. A minimum of \$2,000 will be awarded for this scholarship.
