TENTATIVE BUDGET TIMELINE

October 2022-January 2023 - Departmental discussion and budget meetings

<u>January 18, 2023</u> – Received State budget guidelines

<u>February 7, 2023</u> – Initial board presentation on 2023/24 budget timeline, enrollment and key developments

February 21, 2023 - Preliminary Budget Presentation

February 28, 2023 - State Budget Address - receive state aid information two days later

<u>March 14, 2023</u> – Board vote on preliminary budget. Tentative date - budget is due to the County office by March 20, 2023

<u>March 20 – April 21, 2023</u> – County review and approval

April 25, 2023 - Public Hearing on budget

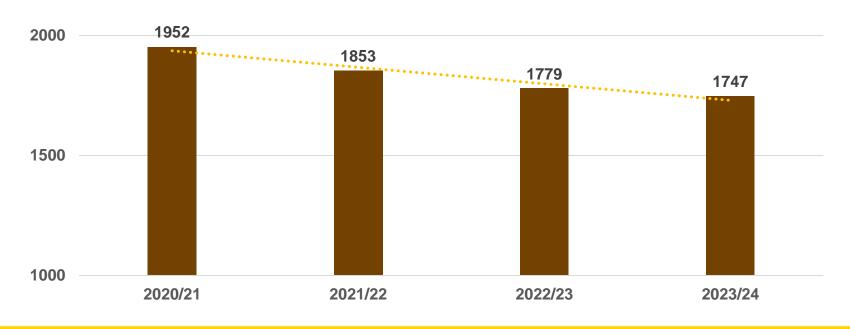


Key Developments for 2022/23 - Updated

- TRANSPORTATION-BUS DRIVER SHORTAGE NO CHANGE
- COVID 19 PRETTY MUCH DONE THANKFULLY
- > INFLATION/SUPPLY LINE ISSUES ACTUALLY WORSE
- ➤ DECLINING ENROLLMENT/BUILDING SAME, BUT . . .
- RISING HEALTHCARE COSTS ALSO WORSE
- > SOLAR PANELS/ENERGY EFFICIENCIES PROJECT ALMOST DONE
- REGIONALIZATION STUDY NO CHANGE YET
- SPECIAL EDUCATION

REVENUE PROJECTIONS

- > TWO PERCENT (2%) BUDGET CAP 660k FOR \$33 MILLION TAX LEVY
 - CURRENTLY \$2 MILLION OVER CAP
- STATE AID 5% OF OPERATING BUDGET
 - WF ARE BUDGETING FLAT FOR NOW
 - > SLIGHT INCREASE POSSIBLE
- > SEND/RECEIVE TUITION REVENUE
 - ➤ INCREASE OF \$155K APPROXIMATELY 2%
 - > 2021/22 RECONCILATION OF STUDENT COUNT \$400K DUE TO GB-COVERED BY RESERVES
 - FINAL YEAR OF 3-YEAR CONTRACT
- **▶** USE OF SURPLUS
 - > APPROXIMATELY \$950K IN LINE WITH PREVIOUS YEARS
 - > TUITION RESERVE OF \$400K
 - ➤ CAPITAL RESERVE \$5.3 MILLION REFERENDUM PROJECT
