Dear WHRHS Parents/Guardians and Students,

With the information released by The College Board regarding options for the 2021 Advanced Placement (AP) Exams, we wanted to update students and parents on the approved plan to administer these exams at Watchung Hills. The WHRHS administration has approved most exams to be administered to WHRHS students during the Second Administration Testing window (May 18 through May 28). Specific exam dates and times of individual exam administrations can be found posted on the WHRHS website [here](#).

Exams during the Second Administration Testing window are offered either paper or pencil or digitally (only one option for each exam as determined by The College Board). AP proctors will be scheduled to administer all exams during this window on the WHRHS campus. As both paper-pencil and digital formats of the test will be full length this year (2-3 hours standard time), there are a number of benefits to taking the exams in the school environment.

By March 24th, please complete the following [form](#) to indicate your intent to take AP exams during this window as scheduled. If you have extenuating circumstances that requires you to take a digital exam at home, please indicate that using this form. The Third Administration window (June 1 through June 11) will be utilized solely for digital at home exams. Exams during this window must be approved by the AP Coordinators and be due to an illness or conflict with another AP exam or event.

As the exam dates near, students will receive email communications through [Total Registration](#) with specific information about their test location and report times. In addition, student testing digitally will receive information on the technical preparations necessary for their test.
