#### School

Watchung Hills Regional High School is a highly performing secondary institution that is committed to excellence and equity. Our culture of inquiry and collaboration supports a comprehensive academic program, designed to teach students to ask questions, take risks, and solve problems. With emphasis on a growth mindset and social and emotional wellness, we help students discover their passions, discern pathways, and embrace challenges. The student enrollment is approximately 1715 with a senior class of 445.


#### Community


#### **Educational Practices During COVID-19**

Watchung Hills Regional High School transitioned to an asynchronous distance learning model on March 16, 2020. Students continued to earn numeric quarterly grades with the final marking period grading modified to 22% of the total average for all full year courses. For the 2020-2021 school year, the school moved toward full time in-person instruction with all students having the option to return for the fourth marking period. Grading resumed to each marking period accounting for 23% and an exam grade accounting for 8% of the final grade. Athletic seasons were shortened and some co-curricular programs were limited or not offered. Since the start of the 2021-2022 school year, all WHRHS students have been welcomed back for full time in person instruction.

### **GPA Calculation**




