# Preparation and Timeline Overview: What are you doing NOW? Make your Application Impressive!

- □ Application: Demographic/Background Information/School Specific Information for each college
- Academics: The Transcript is your most important credential. Your grades and GPA will be important to your future. Colleges will see senior courses but your grades after this year are your grades. Make the most of Junior Year to demonstrate your academic work, effort, results.
- Develop relationships with your teachers, considering **letters of recommendation** may be required for your college application
- ☐ Activities: What do you like to do outside the classroom
