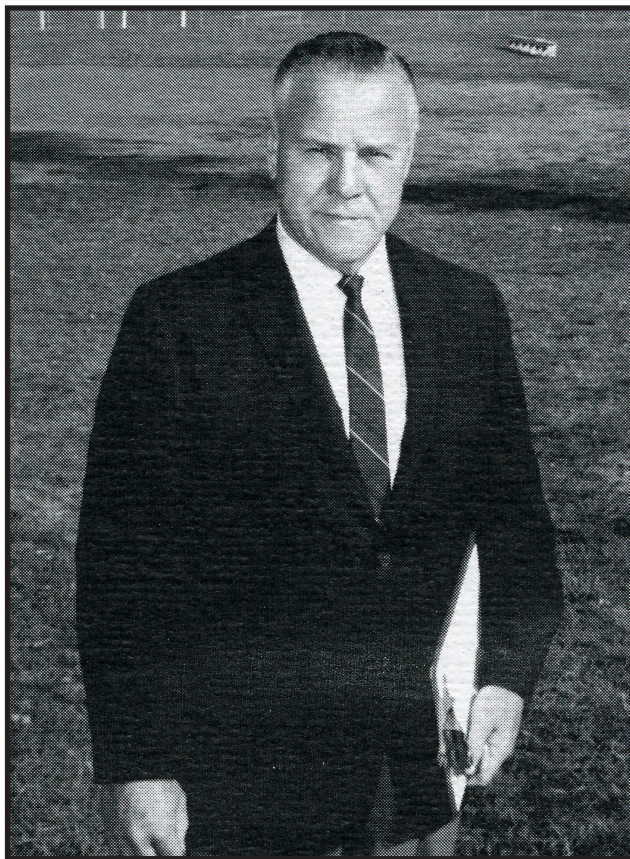

Howard Tozier

Service from 1960 – 1971 • Athletics

Howard Tozier was not part of the staff when Watchung Hills Regional High School opened in 1957, but became a member of the staff shortly thereafter. He joined the Watchung Hills team as Athletic Director/Physical Education teacher and served in that role from 1961 – 1971.

Under Howard's leadership in 1960s, Watchung Hills extra-curricular sports as well as the physical education and health programs grew into one of the most respected in central New Jersey.....Watchung Hills was setting the standard. Howard ushered in many of the freshman, junior varsity, and varsity programs that established the foundation of today's extensive athletic program.

Well ahead of the times, Howard was an active proponent of women's athletic programs. He recognized the educational value of participating on a team for both males and females. He developed and supported many teams and programs specifically designed to benefit the young women of WHRHS.

The administration and the Board of Education understood that Howard Tozier held a special place in the history of Watchung Hills Regional High School. In recognition of Mr. Tozier's contributions to the Watchung Hills' learning community, the football stadium and track complex was named Tozier Stadium in the 1970s. We are proud to induct Howard Tozier into the WHRHS Hall of Fame.
