

Peter Falzarano Class of 1960

Like several others in the freshman class of the Hall of Fame, Pete Falzarano was a sophomore when WHRHS first opened its doors. And looking back at his accomplishments, Pete was one of the first athletically-gifted students to graduate from Watchung Hills Regional High School.

Peter lettered in football, basketball and baseball in each of his years at Watchung Hills and was the first to record a no-hitter for the Hills baseball team. Peter was also the first student-athlete at WHRHS to be offered a full athletic scholarship for college. Peter selected North Carolina State University where he played football from 1960-1964.

Peter returned to Watchung Hills to teach Physical Education in 1969 and served as varsity baseball coach from 1971-1976. Under Pete's direction, the varsity team won the Somerset County Conference Championships in 1975 and the Mid-State Conference Championship in both 1975 and 1976.

In 1979 Pete decided to accept the position of Athletic Director with Jonathon Dayton Regional High School in Springfield, a position that he held from 1979 - 2000.

Despite moving his career out of WHRHS, Pete maintained his loyalty to the school and the community by his continious service on the WHRHS Board of Education beginning in 1987 and through the present.

Peter has also been a member of the Stirling Volunteer Fire Department since 1966.
