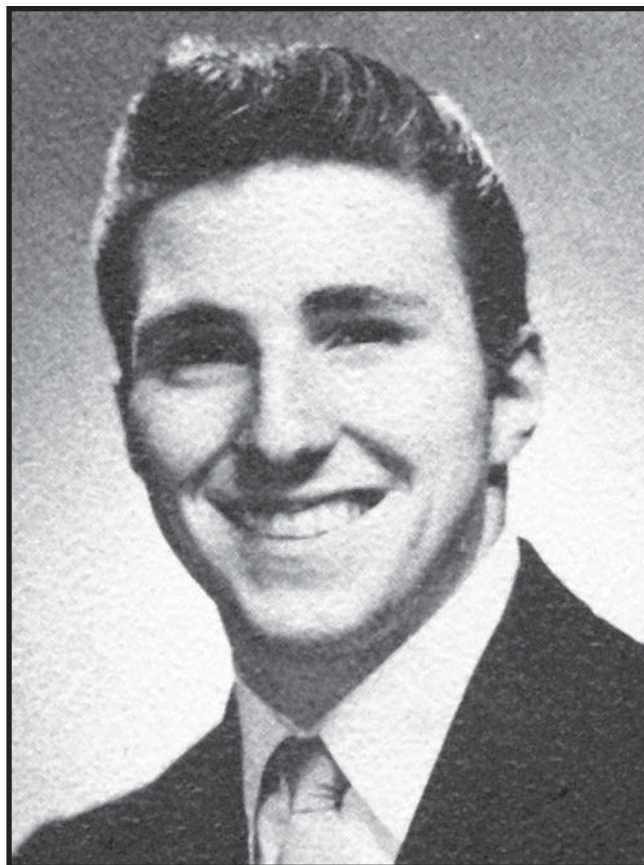


Watchung Hills Regional High School

George joins several other early attendees of Watchung Hills Regional High School in the WHRHS Hall of Fame. George was a member of the freshman class in 1957. He was a standout in three sports – football, wrestling, and gymnastics. In addition to athletic involvement, George helped shape the character of the school, being a member of the All-School Council from 1959 – 1961. Many of the protocols that George helped to shape still exist today at WHRHS.

Exemplifying the WHRHS spirit, George expanded his commitment after his graduation to serve in many capacities. He has taken leadership roles in Long Hill for many years. He served as Mayor of Long Hill in 1987, 1988, and 1993. He was elected to the Long Hill township committee from 1985 – 1993, serving in other community leadership roles while on the township committee.

George’s commitment to serve was not confined to local activities only. George also served his country as a member of the Army National Guard from 1961 – 1996. In addition George participated on a number of statewide committees related to high school athletics.
