Watchung Hills Regional High School is recognized for a number of very successful alumni. Lisa Rosamilia Laughinghouse is part of WHRHS's legacy largely because of her significant dominance of women's tennis locally and regionally during her high school years.

Lisa was an All-State tennis player from 1980-1984. She captured two consecutive New Jersey State and individual girls' tennis championships. She ended her high school career with a 130-3 record, never losing a regular season match. She was also the first female high school player to win 100 matches — pretty impressive stuff. Her accomplishments were recognized by Sports Illustrated magazine, as she was listed in "Faces in the Crowd" in 1982. Only extra special athletes find their way into that section of Sports Illustrated. Lisa was that special.

Lisa was awarded a scholarship to Boston College, where she continued to impress on the tennis court. She competed at the varsity level all four years winning several individual and team Big East championships.

Lisa now makes her home in Fair Haven, New Jersey, with her husband, Dr. Ken Laughinghouse, who is also a WHRHS graduate.
