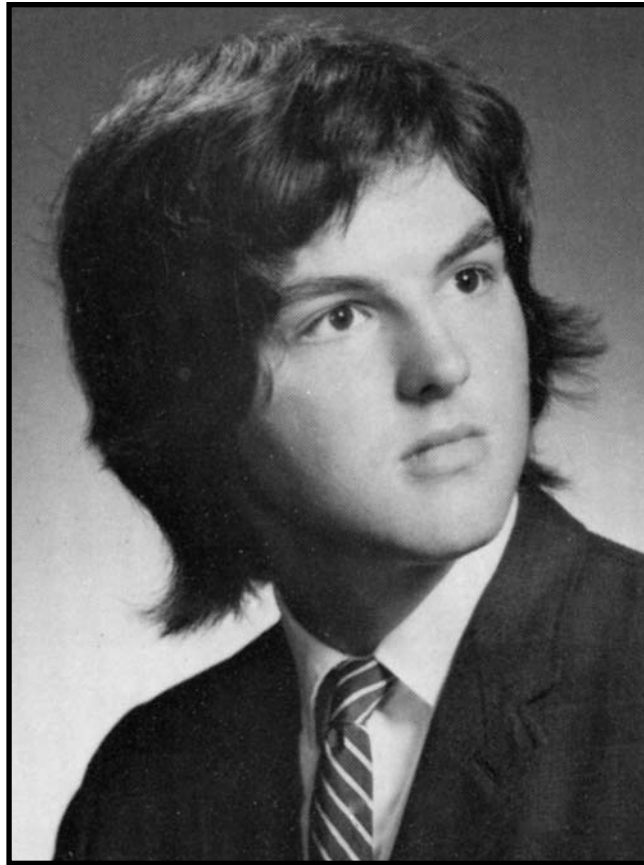


Watchung Hills Regional High School Hall of Fame

Even as a student in the Class of 1970, Alan LeBoeuf's career path was evident. As a sixteen-year-old, he flew to Hollywood to sing a jingle on national TV, and, a talented bass guitarist, he performed at Hills dances and proms with a succession of bands.

After graduating from Rutgers, he pursued a career in the entertainment industry. His first major break was landing a role as "Paul McCartney" in Broadway's hit "Beatlemania." After two years in that role, he moved to Nashville, Tenn., and formed "Baillie and the Boys," with former band-mates. Together, they signed with RCA and had seven straight Top Ten hits on the country charts, recorded three albums and a "greatest hits" album together.

Alan has appeared with major symphony orchestras with the "Classical Mystery Tour," has performed on five continents as well as in American venues such as Las Vegas and Walt Disney World.

One of the busiest Beatlemania alumni, Alan's other credits include twelve TV appearances on The Nashville Network. He has appeared in national commercials for well-known products, written songs and movie soundtracks, and has supplied vocal back-up to numerous performers.

Back on Broadway in 2010, Alan once again plays Paul of Beatlemania fame in the hit show "Rain."
