Dear Warrior Students and Parents/Guardians:

As we look forward to welcoming the Class of 2025 and returning students next week, this letter provides important information related to student schedules and counselor assignments.

The scheduling process requires much time and careful consideration involving input from students, parents, teachers, counselors, and school administrators. When requesting courses this past Spring for the upcoming school year, students made a commitment to these selections which determined the master schedule.

In reviewing the posted course schedule in our district's SIS Genesis, it is important to note the following:

- 1. Schedules reflect your student's grade level for 2021-2022. Students are promoted to grade 10 if they have earned 33 credits; to grade 11 if they have earned 66 credits; and to grade 12 if they have earned 98 credits. As noted in the Program of Studies, students need 131 credits to meet WHRHS graduation requirements.
- 2. As a reminder, we are unable to honor requests for specific teacher assignments and/or make changes to elective course placements.

To find your counselor assignment log into your <u>Parent or Student Access account</u> and the counselor is listed on the Summary page. Please contact your counselor if one of the following schedule conflicts exists:

- 1. To address a course sequence issue (i.e. scheduled for a course without the required prerequisite).
- 2. A course adjustment is needed for a 12th grade student to fulfill graduation requirements.

Please understand that schedule change requests will only be reviewed if they impact graduation required courses and/or prerequisites. If you have difficulty logging into your Genesis account, please email parentconnect@whrhs.org for assistance. We look forward to seeing you all soon!
